

PAST HAMBURG NFL PP&K SECTIONAL FINALIST



Frontier & Hamburg Team Up to Take Sectionals and More

Jimmy May and Kara Daly each smashed through their respective local 2009 NFL Punt, Pass & Kick (PP&K) competition hosted by HamburgSports.com and Hamburg Little Loop Football. Over 3.5 million kids between 8 and 15 years old participate annually in the NFL's PP&K competition. Both qualified last week at the sectionals where they each joined an elite group of 160 in the nation for their respective age brackets. Jimmy May (Frontier) and Kara Daly (Hamburg) both student-athletes, former Hamburg Little Loop Football Quarterbacks, and prior Sectional Champions, qualified for the Buffalo Bills Team where they each took first place in their respective age groups. This ranks each of them in the top 32 of the country, both now have a chance to make the NFL's National Team with a chance to compete with the top 4 at an NFL Championship game for the final round.



Hamburg Little Loop Football Gets One Called to the NFL

Kara Daly ripped through the local completion and qualified for the 2007 NFL Punt, Pass & Kick (PP&K) Sectionals at Hamburg Little Loop Football with score of 168 points and later took 1st place at the State Sectional competition at Ralph Wilson Field House for the 8-9 year old group.
